Nose Bag Lunch

"Nose bag" is a Girl Scout term for a lunch you can carry. When a horse is away from his home quarters, their owner can provide a nose bag (sack) of feed that hangs on his bridle! You can carry your own personal "nose bag" in a bandana, lunch bag, etc. Here are directions to make nose bag lunch!

Materials:

- Stick or rod
- Bandana or square cloth
- Lunch or snacks

Directions:

- 1. Lay the bandana flat.
- 2. Place your food in the middle of the bandana.
- 3. Tie one pair of opposite diagonal corners together with a simple knot (A).
- 4. Place the stick on top of the knot, with several inches hanging over the side.
- 5. Then tie the two remaining corners to together, securing it to the stick (B).
