Girl Scouts Offering 5-Week, In-Person Sampler Program for Girls in Grades K-5 in Horseheads

Horseheads, N.Y. (November 17, 2020) —Beginning this Thursday, staff from [Girl Scouts of NYPENN Pathways](#) (GSNYPENN) is hosting a five-week, in-person winter sampler program for girls in grades K-5 to learn more about Girl Scouting. The program takes place at the council's Horseheads Service Center, 226 Colonial Dr.

The staff-led series offers a sampler program filled with Girl Scout traditions, STEM activities, a community service project and badges selected by the girls based on their interests.
