# Key Deadlines

- Proposal Submission\*: Submit no later than March 1 of your high school graduation year.
- Final Report Submission\*\*: Submit by September 30 of your high school graduation year.
- Approval Process: The proposal prep and approval can take 1-2 months, so plan accordingly.
- Project Duration: Gold Award projects typically take at least one year, so starting early is important.

## Gold Award Proposal and Project Approval Process

- 1. Complete Required Training on gsLearn
  - Request access via the "Request youth member access to gsLearn" form.
  - o After completing the training, you'll receive a link to gogold for proposal submission.

#### 2. Download the Guide

o <u>Download</u> and read **"Your Guide to Going Gold"** from the Gold Award <u>webpage</u> for reference during the proposal process.

#### 3. Complete Proposal Steps

- o Complete Steps 1-4 in gogold.
- o Have an adult proofread your proposal.
- o Obtain electronic verification from your adult volunteer and project advisor.
- Submit your proposal by clicking Step 5.

## 4. Proposal Review

- o After submission, if basic requirements are met, you'll be assigned two mentors from the Gold Award Committee.
  - These mentors will arrange a virtual meeting to review your proposal.
  - They'll offer suggestions and help you prepare for your presentation.
- 5. Mentor Meeting and Final Approval Preparation
  - o Meeting with Mentors: After your mentors review your proposal, they'll notify the council when it's ready for presentation.
  - Respond promptly to any updates or requests to keep the process moving smoothly.

o If requested, update your proposal promptly, and once approved, the council will invite you to present.

## 6. Presentation and Feedback

- o After the presentation to the committee, you'll receive feedback within a week.
- o Feedback will be one of the following:
  - Approved
  - Approved with additions
  - Questions for clarification (may require proposal updates/resubmit)
- o If further updates are needed, make them promptly.
- o Once your proposal is approved, you can begin your project!

## **Key Considerations**:

- Allow plenty of time for each step, as proposal preparation and approval can take several months.
- Start early to ensure ample time for your project, which typically requires at least a year to complete.

By following these steps and staying on top of deadlines, you can successfully navigate the Gold Award process!
