## **GSNYPENN Silver Award Requirements:**

- All team members are registered Cadettes in 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, or 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
- All team members have completed a Cadette Journey including the Journey
   Take Action project at the end before beginning the Silver Award. (Journey
   completion hours do not count as Silver Award hours.)



- The project is led by up to four Cadettes or one solo Cadette.
- Each team member spends a minimum of 50 hours of work on project.
- Each Cadette and adult volunteer complete the council <u>required</u> Silver Award training on gsLearn prior to starting work on the award.

## **Troop/Group Leader Responsibilities:**

- 1. Complete council required **Adult Volunteer Silver Award training** on gsLearn.
- 2. Download the <u>Adult Guide to Earning the Silver Award</u> and the <u>Cadette Workbook for Earning your</u>
  <u>Silver Award</u> from our Silver Award webpage.
- 3. Ensure all Cadettes complete the council required **Cadette Silver Award training** on gsLearn. (Girl Scouts aged 13 and older can <u>request youth gsLearn access</u> from our <u>Silver Award webpage</u>.)
- 4. Guide team to complete all steps and develop project by using the Cadette Silver Award workbook.
- 5. Ensure all GSUSA and GSNYPENN policies and safety guidelines are followed. (<u>Policies</u> and <u>Safety</u> Activity Checkpoints on our website.)
- 6. Ensure Award project meets requirements for a <u>Take Action project</u> and is not only a community service project.
- 7. Prepare and assist Cadettes with the Silver Award proposal submission process. Read the proposal before they submit to ensure all relevant information is included. (Submission link provided when training acknowledgement is received.)
- 8. Proposals must be submitted no later than May 1 of the 8th grade year.
- 9. If needed, submit a <u>Money Earing Activity</u> (MEA) request form for project fundraising activity approval. (All in-kind donations must be <u>preapproved</u>.)
- 10. Ensure Cadettes submit the final report to council by 9/1 the year the oldest team member enters ninth grade. (*Report link provided with approval email.*)
- 11. Celebrate your group's accomplishment with a special ceremony or other recognition event! (Service Unit Managers can request a \$50 stipend. Talk to your SUM for details.)
