## Trips & Travel Code of Conduct



These rules and expectations apply to all GSNYPENN day, weekend and extended trips.

- 1. Know the itinerary/daily schedule and be punctual. Remember:
  - To be early is to be on time.
  - To be on time is to be late.
  - To be late is to be left behind.
- 2. Join our What's App group for reminders and updates. (Applies to extended trips.)
- 3. Be considerate on the bus, train, plane, etc.
  - No screaming or excessively loud voices
  - No running up and down the aisles
  - · Keep food and snacks neat, only drink water to avoid sticky spills, take care of your trash
  - Use headphones while using electronics
  - Use the bathroom before boarding
  - Note: We will adhere to the itinerary schedule and will not make extra stops (except in the event of an emergency).
- 4. Be considerate in the hotel.
  - No screaming or excessively loud voices
  - No running through the halls
  - · No jumping on beds
  - No loud music
  - Observe all quiet hours
- 5. Keep your hands to yourself; do not touch another person's belongings without their permission.
- 6. Be considerate and respectful of our tour guides and presenters. Listen attentively and do not talk excessively.
- 7. Be aware that your troop/family is not the only participant on the trip. Be considerate of other youth, parents and troop leaders who are also trying to enjoy their experience.
- 8. Adults must refrain from consuming alcohol for the duration of the trip.
- 9. Use caution before using the television or refrigerator; there may be options that add fees to the hotel room. All youth should ask an adult before using these amenities.
- 10. Swimming in hotel pools will only be allowed when a lifeguard is present. Adults must accompany youth in the pool.
- 11. Remember that you are responsible for any amount over a food voucher's face value, including tips. Please remember to tip appropriately.
- 12. Girl Scout uniforms may be worn at certain activities. Use discretion when deciding when and where to wear your vest or sash, especially if it's an activity that could result in damage or loss of badges/patches.
- 13. Never travel alone. Always travel with an adult. Use the rule of three; always travel in groups of three or more.
- 14. Remember to have fun and represent Girl Scouts appropriately!
